What does it mean to be part of a community?
Children learn about belonging to clubs, groups and organisations

READING – We will be reading:

GEOGRAPHY

We will:

... Do a short recap on oceans and continents.

...Explore where mini beasts live; Compare bugs found in our school grounds to bugs found in the rainforest; Begin to understand climate and temperature in the rainforest.

MUSIC – We will:

Recap all songs covered this year; Learn to play along on the glockenspiel; Learn about the composer Tchaikovsky; Make a variety of sounds using boom whackers.

PE –

Tennis: Understanding and practising the action we use when playing a tennis shot. Learning to hit the tennis ball with a racket correctly. Practising hitting a tennis ball to a partner. Going on to perform a tennis rally with a partner.

Athletics will include

Lane running, throwing and a standing long jump

Year 2 Summer 2 'Wriggle and Crawl'

We will be finding out all about minibeasts and their habitats. We will explore the school grounds and nature garden to find creepy crawlies as well as making our own bug hotels and find out why bees are important. Explore pond life and dragonflies.



SCIENCE - We will be...

Explaining life cycles of a Frog and a Butterfly. Classifying minibeasts by answering a series of questions such as 'Does it have wings? OR How many legs?' We will be exploring human and animal basic needs and learning about what our body needs to stay healthy. We will be labelling the body parts of insects and learning what makes an insect different from a spider.

MATHS -We will be learning about:

Position and Direction
Multiplication and division

Weight, Volume and temperature
Measuring and comparing mass in grams and kilograms
