## **History**

To know 5 songs off by heart.

To know that music has a steady pulse, like a heartbeat.

To confidently sing or rap five songs from memory and sing them in unison.

## Attack, defend, shoot

To know that in competitive situations you need attackers and defenders.

### MATHS

Ordering numbers to 100. Place value. Adding more than two numbers. Subtraction. Weight. Coin recognition. Shape. Bridging ten. Symmetry. Data. Length. Weeks and Months. 2's and 10's. Halves, doubles and quarters.
