



Geography

This half term we will be investigating the British export trade and farming worldwide. We will be studying locations on their suitability for growing crops through the use of digital data, maps and fieldwork.

READING

Identify themes across a text. Build on our understanding of author choices and the impact of language.



WRITING

Be inspired by The Secret Garden to write our own stories and write instructions to help others grow their own food.

RHE

To explore how we can show God's love to others. Understand how we can resist pressures and how feelings can impact actions. Learn to keep safe online. Understand the effects of substances on health.

MUSIC

Learn about rap music with The Fresh Prince of Bel-Air. Know some of the style indicators of the songs and what the song lyrics are about. Listen to and follow musical instructions from a leader.

PE – Hockey and orienteering

Combine basic hockey skills such as dribbling and push pass. Select and apply skills in a game. Play effectively in different positions on a pitch including defence. Learn the key features of a map and compass and use it to navigate in a team.



This half term, we'll learn about allotments and farming. We will investigate different techniques to growing plants and different farming practises around the world. We will be inspired by the colours of gardens and crops to create great artwork. Maps will help us to identify the best place for an allotment and where different foods come from. We will get green fingers through learning to grow our own food and learn how to take care of our plants.

SCIENCE

We will be learning about the aging process in humans and hope to talk with someone about their experiences to gain a better understanding of this. We will be studying and comparing the life cycles of mammals, amphibians, insects and birds. We will get to observe some of the stages of the life cycles of butterflies, chickens and frogs. We will learn about the life process of reproduction in some plants and animals. Throughout this half term we will develop our recording and classifying skills.

MATHS

Use the short multiplication and division method. Recognise and use thousandths and relate them to tenths, hundredths and decimal equivalents. Recognise the percent symbol (%) and write percentages as a fraction with denominator 100, and as a decimal.

RE

Understand the different liturgies of Holy Week and the Easter vigil. Appreciate the cost of giving and how belief in the sacrifice Jesus made, and belief in the Resurrection shapes lives.

Learn about Pentecost - make links between scripture and God's gift of the Holy Spirit and forgiveness. Explore reasons for certain actions of Christians inspired by the Holy Spirit.

ART/DT

We will be exploring colour through different mediums. Understand the terms: hue, tint, tone, shades and mood. Know artists who use colour to portray their ideas and meanings. Explore the use of texture in colour and use colour for purposes. Use a variety of mediums and mix colours to the desired shade/tone (water colour, poster paint, pastels).
