What we are learning this term:

This term our main topic will be all about the Anglo Saxons and Vikings. We will explore through History, Drama, Art and ICT what life was like and how people lived.

<u>English</u>

settings using powerful adjectives as well as expanded noun phrases and using adverbs to begin our sentences. We will write our own Kennings and revisit how to set out dialogue.

Homework

Spellings are tested every Thursday.

Maths and English will be set on IXL and we will issue the passwords next week

All homework will relate to class work, so children should be able to complete it independently.

Times tables

In year 4 now the children are expected to know all of their times tables from 2's to 12's.
