Using a bat to hit and return a ball/beanbag.

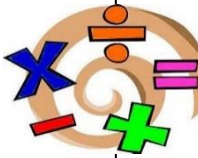
MATHS

READING

The children will be reading a stimulating narrative text to deepen their knowledge of the world. They will be studying France (the book setting), bee life and natural ecosystems.



WRITING

Using 'The Bee that Spoke' the children will: write poetry (what I see out of the window), learn how to write character and setting descriptions. They will learn about persuasive writing through writing about a favourite gift.

Science led topic Summer 2022



SCIENCE Aims:

To understand that the local environment is a habitat for living things. To identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees. To observe objects, materials, living things and changes over time and sort them. To sort pictures of animals- those that can live in the home or in local environment. To learn the names for main parts of a plant. To understand if something is alive or dead. To plant seeds and bulbs and know what they need to survive.



RE

Holidays and holydays

Understanding that each one of us, by the way we lead our lives, the way we treat others, and by our words and actions, show our attitude in serving each other. Know that the Holy Spirit, who was sent by God, is there to help us and that Pentecost is a special holiday for Christians.



Being sorry
