



Nazi laws in Germany meant that Jewish people:

- Couldn't go to school
- Couldn't marry people who weren't Jewish
- Weren't allowed to vote
- Weren't allowed to do many jobs

Nazi soldiers


For example, when Otto Deutsch was 10 years old, there were new laws in Austria where he lived:

'A Jew mustn't own a bicycle, nor a pet. I went to the local park and saw a sign saying **Jews forbidden** – I wasn't allowed to kick my football about in the park.'


The Holocaust




The Nazis killed 6 million Jewish people during the Holocaust.

Ivor Perl talks to lots of groups about his experiences during the Holocaust.




