Write a narrative story using fronted adverbials, repetition, correct tense and appropriate determiners. We are looking to create our own legend story based on the Pied Piper.

READING

We are reading Charlottes Web by E.B White this half term

PSHE

Staying safe online and understanding the role of the church in everyday life.

MUSIC

Learning about the Beatles, a selection of their famous songs and the history behind them.

PE

Rounders - Developing accuracy in striking, fielding and throwing.

Athletics - developing our running, jumping and throwing accuracy. Using correct pace and stride for different events.

What's that noise? A bash? A crash? A shake, a rattle or a low, bass hum? Which do you prefer - an acoustic singer or a booming brass band? SCIENCE

Use models, diagrams and animations to find out and understand how the human ear works. Draw diagrams to explain how the different parts work, labelling them correctly with scientific terms, Talk about how sound (vibrations) travels through different objects.

MATHS

Recognise and round decimals to 2 decimal places.

Know the values of pounds and pence. Link this with work on decimals. Rounding and ordering amounts of money. Solving Money word problems. Revising number factors and division and multiplication methods.

Learning our multiplication tables in preparation for the Multiplication Tables Check after half term.

RE

Learning about the events of Pentecost and recounting the actions of the apostles afterwards. We are looking in detail at St Paul and how he travelled around the Mediterranean, spreading the Good News of Jesus.

ART/DT

We are researching and drawing famous album covers using light, scale and proportion in our work to make accurate copies.

ICT

Recording audio using devices and software, editing audio using software, selecting appropriate audio files, combining them for effect and planning a podcast.
