



HISTORY

The children will be learning about childhood, linking their own experiences to those of childhood in the 1950's. They will be able to sequence photos of themselves as a baby, toddler and child as well as learning about family trees. They will be learning about lifestyles and childhood in the 1950's and be able to recognise similarities and differences of 1950's childhoods and their own. They will learn about the coronation of Queen Elizabeth II and when this took place.

READING & Daily phonics

There will be daily phonics and guided reading three times a week. They will use a main class text to develop reading skills and to link with writing lessons.

WRITING

Using a class text the children will work towards independent story writing. In the lessons, we will be looking at writing effective sentences, using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.

We will also begin looking at and working on a non-fiction text.



RHE:

The children will learn that we are unique, with individual gifts, talents and skills. They will know that girls and boys have been created by God to be similar and different. The children will also be learning what constitutes a healthy lifestyle, such as healthy eating and physical activity.



MUSIC

To know music has a steady pulse.

To know we can create rhythms from words, our names, favourite foods, colours and animals.

PE

Dance –

The children will be using dance to explore space, direction, levels and speeds. They will be able to perform with different body parts and explore story telling through dance. They will be developing actions that express friendship.

Football –

The children will be learning football skills through a sports coach.

SCIENCE

The children will be learning about the human body. They will be able to know a variety of different body parts and label these correctly.

They will also be learning what the 5 senses are and know which part of the body is associated with each sense.

MATHS

Numbers to 10, part-whole within 10, addition and subtraction within 10, 2D and 3D shapes and numbers to 20.

RE

Belonging.

The children will learn about belonging to different groups. They will learn about Baptism and know that Baptism is an invitation to belong to God's family. They will be able to describe some actions and symbols used in a Baptism ritual.

Advent.

The children will be learning about waiting and discussing if waiting is always difficult. They will understand that Advent is a time of waiting in hope for Jesus and how waiting encourages believers to wait for Christ. They will know that gifts, given and received are a sign and expression of love.

ART/ DT

The children will be looking at a range of toys from now and from the 1950's.

They will be designing and making three of their own toys from the 1950's, using simple joins, cutting and folding.
