PSHE To know that their increasing independence brings increased responsibility to keep themselves and others safe. To know how to use technology safely. To know what we eat can make us healthy or make us ill.

SCIENCE – Animals Including Humans

We will be learning that animals cannot make their own food and need to get nutrition from the food they eat. Carnivores get their nutrition from eating other animals. Herbivores get their nutrition from plants. Omnivores get their nutrition from eating a combination of both plants and other animals. We will also be recording and displaying data in different ways, including tables, charts, graphs and labelled diagrams. Data can be used to provide evidence to answer questions.

RE

Retell some of the stories of Holy Week and the Resurrection.

Describe the religious actions and symbols of Lent and Holy Week.

Describe some ways in which Christians use the time of Lent to give to others.

DT

We will be designing and make mini greenhouses.

The children will be exploring which structures are the strongest and which materials are best to use for the windows.

We will be learning to saw and join wood safely before evaluating our designs.
