



## English

Organise ideas in logical sequence creating links between paragraphs. Use features of layout such as text boxes, subheadings and captions for a tourist brochure. Proof read and up level work checking spelling and grammar and use a thesaurus to expand vocabulary. Plan and write diaries, stories Non-chronological reports and speeches.



## Reading

Find and record information from nonfiction developing note taking skills using bullet points. Read and discuss Native American legends. Discuss words and phrases that capture a reader's imagination Make inferences about characters feelings.

## Geography :

Compare how areas of the world have capitalised on their physical or human features Locate the states within the USA. Find out where Native American tribes lived and how they used natural resources for shelter food and transport. Find out about the Mississippi and Missouri rivers.

## Science : Electricity

Name devices that use electricity. Learn circuit symbols. Construct a circuit using a range of components and switches. Sort out and classify materials that are conductors and insulators. Predict which materials will be insulators. Test how different circuits affect the brightness of a bulb.

## French :

Family, clothes challenge, French food :Design a French Menu, Cut out labels from French Foods, Research Famous French Chefs, Cook/Buy and photograph some French food to taste,

## Mathematics

Convert between units of time. 12 and 24 hour clock Statistics - interpretation of pictograms, bar charts and tables Geometry - properties of shapes Position and direction, describe coordinate positions and translations
