



### Geography

Learn about the impact of tourism on an area and identify cause and effect.

Use maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate countries.

### PE

Select, combine and develop skills to play competitively in cricket games. Run for speed and distance, improve jumping and throwing techniques and work as a team in athletics.

### MATHS

Solve problems involving number up to three decimal places, including multistep problems. Use the properties of rectangles to deduce related facts and find missing lengths and angles. Convert between different units of measure and time.

### READING

Order key events and use the context to determine the meaning of new words. Look at how suspense is created.



### WRITING

Write exciting mystery stories and learn to build suspense for our readers. Revisit persuasive writing by creating adverts.



### RE

Learn about the transforming power of the Holy Spirit and how it shapes the lives of Christians. Make links between the Holy Spirit and teachings of forgiveness.

During a unit on Hinduism, learn about Brahman and the ways in which Brahman is made visible. Learn about pilgrimage and understand how beliefs impact choices.

### RHE

Understand how the Holy Spirit is a gift to help us follow God's teaching and help others. Explore the principles of Catholic Social Teaching and find ways in which we can spread God's love in the community.

We will research the best theme parks around the world and find out about the tourism they generate. Using our new knowledge, we will design a new ride and create eye-catching, persuasive adverts.

### ART

### MUSIC

### SCIENCE

Question the effects of different forces and carry out fair tests to find answers. Develop scientific reporting skills and evaluate our investigations. Observe forces in action in the world around us. Discover how some mechanisms allow a smaller force to have a greater effect.
