


COVE

Bands of soft rock with hard rock on the sides.
Waves crash against the rocks and eat away at the soft rock called erosion.

ESTUARY

The estuary is the mouth of the river. The tide goes in and out and boats bob up and down on the tide. There is lots of human activity. Towns with an estuary often have mouth in there name like Weymouth.



SALT MARSH
