## Geography

The children will be looking at our school and the local area. They will be able to name and locate the 4 countries in the UK as well as locating Wool on a map. They will learn what an address is and how to give directions. They will also be looking at land use in our school, as well as discussing the human and physical features in our school

## **READING**

There will be daily phonics and guided reading in the class.

#### WRITING

The children will be looking at a non-fiction report text and will learn about the different features before having a go at writing their own report independently. They will also continue looking at narrative writing.
